Materials Growth/Characterization

The Materials Processing Division of the Pennsylvania State University Electro-Optics Center (EOC) is seeking several undergraduate research assistant positions. The candidate will be responsible for sample preparation and characterization that may include atomic force microscopy, x-ray diffraction, Raman spectroscopy, and electrical measurements of semiconductor devices and test structures.

Candidates for this position should be at least in their sophomore year of a four year bachelor's degree program in Materials Science, ChemE, EE, Physics, or related major.

The position will be located at the Materials Research Institute (MRI) in Innovation Park as well as Steidle and EE West buildings.

Starting salary will be \$10.50/hr with annual increases based on performance. We expect ~ 10-15 hours/week with a schedule that is flexible depending on classes. Internship positions will be available during the 2010 summer for those students who excel during the FA/SP semesters. US citizenship is required.
